## Proclamation

Whereas, in 2018, working women constitute 76 million women ages 16 and over in the labor force representing 46.9% of the total labor force and strive to serve their communities, their states and their nation in professional, civic and cultural capacities; and

Whereas, in 2018, women's median annual earnings were 81.6% of men's for full-time, year-round workers, and 63.9% of women with earnings worked full-time, year-round compared with 76.3% men; and

Whereas, in 2018, there were 12.3 million women-owned businesses, generating \$1.8 trillion in sales and employing 9.2 million people; and

Whereas, working women should be applauded for their contributions to the workplace and the financial stability of their families especially during the economic downturn when more women have become their family's breadwinner; and

Whereas, the major goal of Business and Professional Women's Foundation and Business and Professional Women/Florida along with its local members is to promote equality for all women and to help create better conditions for working women through the study and advocacy of social, educational and economic issues impacting women in the workplace; and

Whereas, since 1983, National Business Women's Week has honored the contributions of working women and employers who support working women and their families; and

Whereas, the mission is to achieve equality for all women in the workplace through advocacy, education and information; and

Whereas, the organization's objectives include to elevate the standards for women in business and professions, to promote the interests of business and professional women, to bring about a spirit of cooperation among business and professional women of Florida, and to extend opportunities to business and professional women through education along lines of industrial, scientific and vocational activities.
