SUBJECT / TOPIC: Electric Vehicle Charging Equipment Agreement – ChargeUP! Sarasota County

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Sarasota County Government offers a program entitled ChargeUP! Sarasota County which provide rebates to certain types of businesses, non-profits and local governments within Sarasota County for the installation of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations. Program participants would be eligible for 50 percent of cost, up to \$4,000 for the installation.

The Utilities Department has chosen the Water Treatment Plant (200 Warfield Ave. N.) for the installation of a Level 2 (240-volt) Electric Vehicle charging station with the capacity to charge two vehicles simultaneously. It will be available to any resident, visitor, etc. 24 hours a day, at no charge.
