# CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO WORK ASSIGNMENT NO. 2 PURSUANT TO THE JULY 13, 2010, AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA AND MWH AMERICAS, INC.

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2010, the City of Venice, Florida ("OWNER") and MWH Americas, Inc. ("CONSULTANT"), entered into an Agreement whereby the CONSULTANT would perform professional services for the OWNER pursuant to an executed Work Assignment; and

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2012, the parties entered into Work Assignment No. 2 for the purposes of CONSULTANT providing assistance to the OWNER regarding the membrane replacement, equipment and supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) work at the OWNER's Reverse Osmosis Water Treatment plant (ROWTP); and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to enter into Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$76,000.00, which is for the purposes of extending the services described under Tasks 4 and 5 of Work Assignment No. 2; and

WHEREAS, the OWNER wishes to authorize the CONSULTANT to continue to perform professional services described in Task 4 and Task 5 of Work Assignment No. 2; and

WHEREAS, the CONSULTANT wishes to perform such professional services,

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants contained in the July 13, 2010, Agreement, Work Assignment No. 2, and this Change Order, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. General description of the project: The work will consist of extending the same services under Work Assignment No. 2 for Tasks 4 and 5, which provide for continuation of construction and startup phase management and overall project management.
- 2. Scope of services to be performed: CONSULTANT shall perform the services described in the Scope of Services attached hereto as Attachment "A."
- 3. Initial compensation plus Change Order No. 1 compensation to be paid: Owner shall pay the CONSULTANT the initial fixed fee amount of three hundred seventy-three thousand thirty dollars (\$373,030.00) plus the fixed fee amount of seventy-six thousand dollars (\$76,000.00), the latter amount of which may be adjusted by the amount of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) per week to accommodate the actual completion week by the OWNER's contractor. In addition, an amount of twenty

- thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) is authorized as an OWNER's allowance to be used at the OWNER's sole discretion.
- 4. The OWNER and the CONSULTANT agree that the services described in Attachment A will continue with total compensation under Work Assignment No. 2 of four hundred sixty-nine thousand thirty dollars (\$469,030.00), including the OWNER's allowance.
- 5. Period of Service: The Period of Service is extended to October 31, 2014.

### Attachment "A" SCOPE OF SERVICES

#### **Additional Services for**

## OWNER'S REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE REVERSE OSMOSIS MEMBERANE REPLACEMENT AND SCADA SYSTEM DESIGN/BUILD PROJECT

#### **Scope of Services:**

#### Task 4 –Construction and Start-up Phase management

Consultant will continue services described under Task 4 in Work Assignment No. 2.

#### Task 5 -- Project Management and Coordination

Consultant will continue services described under Task 5 in Work Assignment No. 2

#### **Deliverables:**

- Meeting notes from scheduled construction meetings
- Monthly status/progress reports from Task 4
- Periodic correspondence

#### **Compensation:**

CONSULTANT fixed fee is increased by \$76,000.00 for enumerated services, plus \$20,000.00 for the OWNER's allowance, for a total of \$469,030.00.

If the OWNER's contractor completes its work on a schedule different than assumed above, the additional fixed fee may be adjusted by \$3,500.00 per week to accommodate the actual completion week. A summary of tasks is shown below:

Owner's Allowance	\$20,000.00

#### Period of Service:

The Period of Service is extended to October 31, 2104. If the project should be delayed such that the services described above cannot be completed within this timeframe, a change order may be required to provide for changes in staff availability, salary adjustments or other cost and schedule impacts.

#### **Assumptions:**

- Contractor reaches substantial completion no later than October 10, 2014
- Contractor reaches final completion by October 31, 2014
