SUBJECT: Resolution No. 2016-04 Authorizing the City of Venice, Florida to Execute a Joint Participation Agreement for Project Number 431879-1-94-01 with the Florida Department of Transportation for \$144,000 to Design and Construct Apron Rehabilitation

Background:

Various aircraft parking aprons at the Airport have been rated from "Serious (0/100)" to "Poor Condition (33/100)" by a 2015 FDOT Pavement Evaluation Report. These pavements must be reconstructed in order to provide safe and efficient parking places for based and transient aircraft.

FDOT has offered a Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) No. 431879-1-94-01 up to fund 80% of eligible design and construction costs, or \$144,000.

Upon acceptance of the grant funds, the Airport will solicit for professional engineering services to design the project with construction anticipated beginning in 2017. In FY 2017, a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement is anticipated to provide additional funds for construction.

City Attorney:

The City Attorney has reviewed and approved Resolution No. 2016-04 and Joint Participation Agreement No. 436482-1-94-01.

Requested Action:

Staff requests City Council approval of Resolution No. 2016-04 Authorizing the City of Venice, Florida to Execute a Joint Participation Agreement for Project Number 431879-1-94-01 with the Florida Department of Transportation for \$2,180,000 to Design and Construct Apron Rehabilitation.
