JULY 2016 REPORT on RESPONSE to HOMELESS POPULATION

During the month of July, there were 234 responses to individuals who had no known address and answered "yes" to the homeless question.

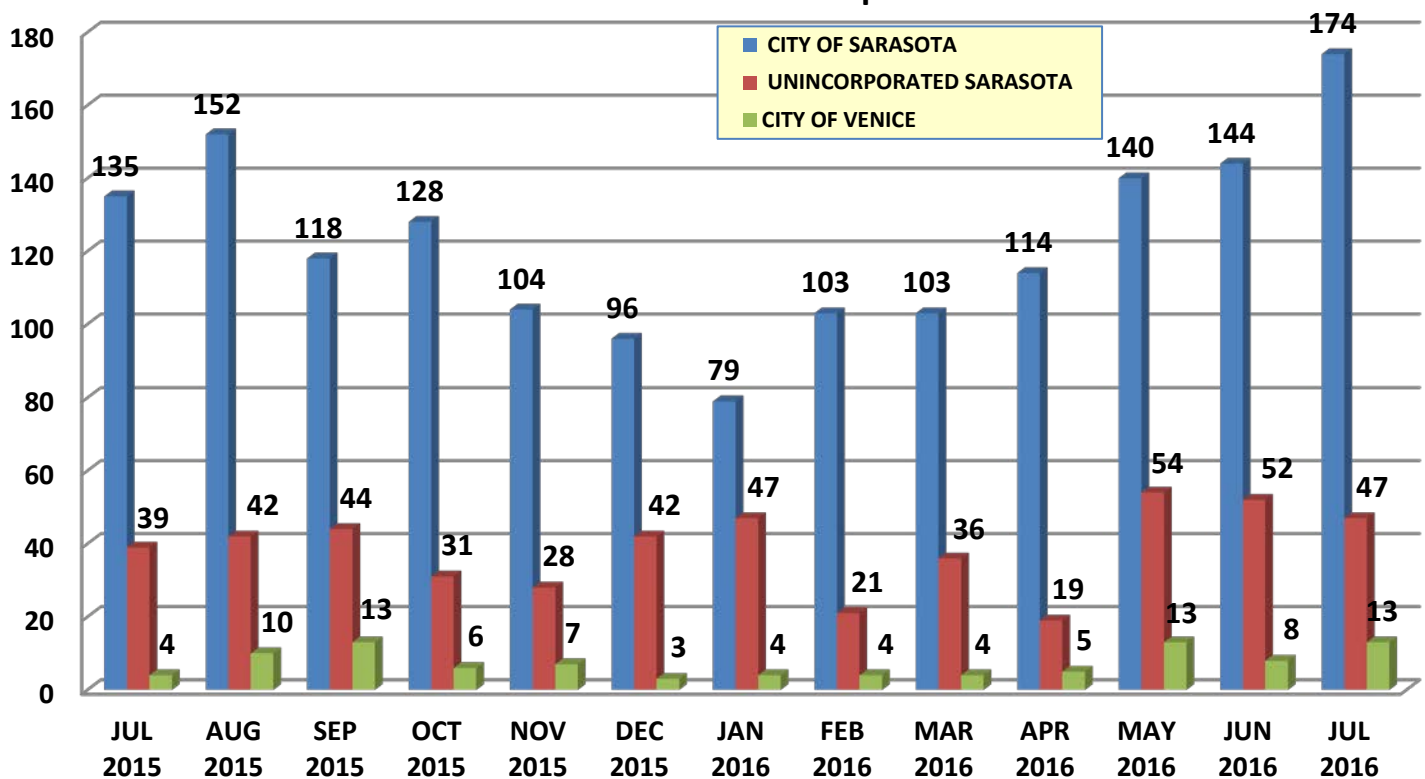
Overall, 91.5% (214/234) were transported to a receiving hospital. This figure is 4.5% of our total transport numbers. A comparison of monthly activity from July 2015 to July 2016 represents a 76.9% increase of transports and an overall increase of 31.5% in the number of calls for this population.

42 individuals requested EMS services more than once and are responsible for 90 additional transports. Of these:

• Two patients were transported 10 times.	• Five patients were transported 4 times.
• One patient was transported 8 times.	• Eight patients were transported 3 times.
• One patient was transported 7 times.	• Twenty-four patients were transported twice.
• One patient was transported 5 times.
