Work Assignment 2016-02 to Taylor Engineering

Environmental Monitoring and Reporting - Venice Beach Renourishment

Background: To comply with the Florida Department of Environment (FDEP) Coastal Permit to construct the Venice Beach Renourishment Project and to complete the required Environmental Monitoring and Reporting to FDEP and the Army Corps of Engineers for state and federal funding, outside professional services are required. In accordance with the September 16, 2016 Agreement between The City of Venice and Taylor Engineering, Inc., Work Assignment 2016-02 in the amount of \$36,912 has been negotiated to meet the Environmental Monitoring and Reporting needs. Separate work assignments have been prepared for Professional Services, Environmental Monitoring and Physical Monitoring to simplify grant reimbursement requests. Since the total of the three work assignments exceeds \$100,000, City Council approval is being requested. Staff recommends approval of

Work Assignment 2016-02.
