SUBJECT:	FY2017 Proposed Budget Amendment for Additional Staffing		

The building division has seen a steady increase in building permit activity over the past five years. To address this, last year City Council approved the addition of a full time plans examiner, multitrade inspector and permit technician. This action was both necessary and extremely helpful. However, from January 1, 2016 thru September 30, 2016, the division has experienced a continual upswing in permit activity. Currently, inspections overall increased by 37% with an increase in single family home permits of 142%. Each single family home requires an average of 20 inspections which indicates there will be a significant increase in future inspection requests. At this rate of growth, the division is in need of two full time multi-trade inspectors. One to be hired immediately and the second to be hired as needed. Along with the demand for our services, permitting fees have increased by 34% which will defer the costs associated with additional staffing.

The Building Division's Special Revenue Fund will support these positions. The cost of increasing the work force has been analyzed by the Finance Department with a determination that the Building Division's revenues can support the additional staff. The cost for both full time positions, with benefits, is estimated at \$170,398 annually.

We are requesting City Council's approval on the hire of two full time multi-trade inspector positions. The requested budget amendment is for \$142,041 to cover salary and benefit costs for the remainder of the fiscal year, \$40,000 for two vehicles, and \$10,500 for computers and operating supplies. Therefore, the division is requesting an FY2017 budget amendment for a total amount of \$192,541.
