Based upon review of the criteria established in accordance with Section 86-49 (c)(1-3) regarding amendments to site and development plans, staff provides the following justification for a minor site and development plan review as follows:

Project Description: The following improvements were approved in the existing Bird Bay Village private recreation area:

- a. Conversion of shuffle board courts to pickle ball courts and the construction of new shuffle board courts.
- b. Associated improvements including concrete walkways, fencing, and landscaping.

(1) Do not meet the thresholds of subsection (b) above (Section 86-49 (b)(1-8));

Staff Comment: Staff has reviewed the proposed project in accordance with the Section 86-49 (b)(1-8) and have determined that the project does not meet the requirements for a major site and development plan amendment. The subject property is already developed as a private community recreational area, no buildings are proposed and architectural standards do not apply.

(2) Clearly meet the requirements of the comprehensive plan and land development code; and

Staff Comment: The Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed recreation area improvements and found them to be consistent with the comprehensive plan and in compliance with all applicable Land Development Code standards.

(3) Are unlikely, in the opinion of the zoning administrator, to have an impact on neighboring properties.

Staff Comment: The proposed recreational facilities, authorized by Bird Bay Village Community Association, Inc., are located entirely within an existing community recreation tract and should have no impact on neighboring properties.
