Atkins North America Work Assignment 2017-03

Downtown Corridor Roadway, Pedestrian, Landscape and Lighting

Background: Work Assignment 2017-03 to Atkins North America has been negotiated to completed the design, permitting and post-design services for the Downtown Corridor Roadway, Pedestrian, Landscaping and Lighting Project. This project includes reconstruction of the existing roadway including curb and gutter (as needed) along W. Venice, Miami and Tampa Avenues between US 41 Business and S. Harbor Drive and upgrading the pedestrian crossings, sidewalks, ADA access, lighting and landscaping. WA 2017-03 also includes developing the construction schedule including detours and signalization plans to minimize the impacts of this large-scale construction project. Multiple of funding sources including Road Bond, FDOT State Legislative Appropriation, FDOT Local Agency Participation (LAP) and One-Cent Sales Tax Funds were combined to make this project a reality. To meet funding deadlines and grant specification, this project has been accelerated and numerous elements including stormwater upgrades have been combined.

Requested Council Action: Authorize the Mayor to Execute Work Assignment 2017-03 Pursuant to the November 30, 2016 Agreement Between City of Venice, Florida and Atkins North America, Inc. in the Amount of \$575,451 to Complete Professional Engineering Services for Design and Permitting of the Downtown Corridor Roadway, Pedestrian, Landscape and Lighting Improvements Project.
