SUBJECT: Request to purchase one "front-loading" refuse truck

Background:

We are seeking approval of the Mayor and City Council to utilize a cooperative purchasing agreement to purchase one "front-loading" refuse truck off of the Florida Sheriff's Association's bid (# FAS16-VEH14.0) through the authorized dealer of Nextran Truck Center.

This truck is 2018 Mack LR613 Cab/Chassis with a Curotto-Can Ready "E-Z" pack 40 cubic yard commercial front loader. This truck is needed, additional to the ones already in service, and will replace older Unit # 473. (Please see the attached memo from Fleet Services, for justification for replacement.) This vehicle that is being replaced will be parted out and then will go to auction. The truck is \$292,227.00, the Public Works-Recycling Division has budgeted this line item in the 2017 Fiscal Year Adopted Budget. The City is utilizing this contract because of the economics of scale and the buying power of the Florida Sheriff's Association's bid.

This request is made in concurrence with John Veneziano, Public Works Director and Bob Moroni, Solid Waste/Recycling Superintendent.

Requested Action:

We therefore are requesting that City Council approve the purchase of this vehicle from the Florida Sheriff's Association bid (# FAS16-VEH14.0).

At the request of the Solid Waste Dept we evaluated the following vehicle:

Unit # 473: The 2006 Mack Front Loader Refuge Truck with over 13,300 hours. The vehicle is in rough condition and has several issues, including cab damage and roof rust. The engine needs to be pulled and resealed. The vehicle also has several cylinders that are leaking. The hydraulic system which controls the EZ Pack system is showing signs of extreme wear. We recommend that this vehicle be considered for replacement at this time.
