Update on City Manager Dispositions

Mr. Lavallee continued his update on "no right turn" on Venice Avenue and Tamiami Trail, police, public works and engineering research regarding a four-way stop at Palermo Place and Riviera Street and staff recommendation for no change, and the relocation of the sign at the former Althea's restaurant to ensure there is no obstruction.

Discussion followed regarding parking ticket statistics, enforcement of parking tickets, parking issues during season, parking identification problem, and future additional parking spaces.

Mr. Lavallee responded to board questions regarding the trolley service to include funding, input on future trolley loops, and receiving public comments.

Discussion followed regarding holding a meeting at the Venice Community Center in July to receive public input on the trolley service and possible locations to hold the June meeting.

Mr. Lavallee continued to review speed limit data, traffic counters, and completion of the bicycle spaces at the crosswalk near TJ Carneys.

Discussion ensued regarding other possible locations for alternate parking.
