Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. Work Assignment 2017-01
Venice Resurfacing Project, Phase 1 – CEI/VT

Background: Work Assignment 2017-01 to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. has been negotiated to complete the Construction Engineering Inspection and Verification Testing for the Venice Resurfacing Project, Phase 1. This project is for the milling, resurfacing and striping of approximately 32.5 total miles of existing roadway, located throughout the City. The project also includes ADA sidewalk ramp upgrades, sidewalk panel replacement, curb replacement and base repairs. WA 2017-01 is to ensure that the Contractor remains in compliance with all Plans and Specifications, through daily field inspections, asphalt plant inspections and field verification testing. These services are necessary to monitor this specialized construction work and to verify a high-quality product has been installed which will last the City for many years to come.

Requested Council Action: Authorize the Mayor to Execute Work Assignment 2017-01 Pursuant to the November 30, 2016 Agreement Between City of Venice, Florida and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. in the Amount of \$276,441.00 to complete the Construction Engineering Inspection and Verification Testing for the Venice Resurfacing Project, Phase 1.
