Sec. 46-66. - Certain parks closed to vehicles during nighttime hours.

(a)

"Vehicles" defined. As used in this section, the term "vehicles" means any motorized device in, upon or by which any person or property may be transported or drawn, including automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, tractors, buses, motorhomes or campers.

(b)

Designated areas; closing time. The following are closed to vehicles between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. daily unless city council orders any of the facilities to be subject to a different closing time:

(1)

Brohard Park (except for those utilizing the fishing pier).

(2)

Chuck Reiter Park.

(3)

Graser Park.

(4)

Hecksher Park.

(5)

Humphris Park (except for those utilizing the jetty for fishing).

(6)

Municipal Beach.

(7)

Patriots Park.

(8)

Service Club Park.

(9)

Venice Wellfield.

(c)

Special driving and parking privileges. These may be authorized by the city manager.

(d)

Exceptions. This section shall not apply to persons having on their person or vehicles a written permit issued by the city manager or to official governmental vehicles.

(e)

Penalty. Any person, except persons falling within the exception set out in subsection (d) of this section, operating a vehicle, whether the owner thereof or not, who enters any city-owned, city-operated or city-leased park, recreational area, beach or beach access named in this section with such vehicle in violation of this section shall, upon conviction, be punished as prescribed in section 1-14 of this Code.
