<u>Response to Mr. Lobeck's Comments:</u> Planning Commission Chairman Barry Snyder, myself, and consultant staff will provide an overall response to Mr. Lobeck's Comments.

Updated Data, Inventory, and Analysis: While the DIA is not adopted as part of the comprehensive plan it is still an important resource as the basis for the Vision, Intent, and Strategy statements that comprise the overall Comprehensive Plan. Included in this meeting packet is an update to the DIA provided by the Consultant. We apologize that this update was not provided at the previous meeting. To clarify, the result of this update was to reformat the document, removing blank areas/spacing, general clean up, and to update page numbers. As a result, there was an overall decrease in the number of pages in the document. The consultant will be available to answer any questions you may have on this topic. As a side note: we continue to review the DIA as well as the Proposed Comprehensive Plan for formatting and typos.

Listing of Comments Received Since June 12, 2017: It should be noted that City Council (to date) has not by vote or consensus indicated any specific changes they would like to the proposed 2017-2027 Comprehensive Plan. However, since the start of the transmittal hearings (June 12, 2017) there have been suggestions, comments, and concerns raised via multiple sources including: testimony provided at the transmittal public hearings, via email or other written correspondence, comments provided directly to staff (City Council members), and comments by staff/city attorney. In an effort to facilitate review and consideration by City Council, staff has provided the attached summary of comments received since the June 12, 2017 transmittal hearing. While we hope to have captured all comments received, if you feel there is a comment/concern that has not been included please let me know or bring it up at the meeting. Our goal in providing this information is for Council to consider each item and by consensus or vote determine if there is a change needed to the plan and specifically what the change should be.
