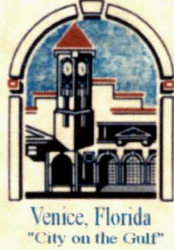


# Office of the Mayor



## Proclamation

**Whereas**, domestic violence is a serious crime that affects people of all ages and income levels, but most often women and children; and once started, the campaign of physical, psychological, economic and domestic violence only gets worse, resulting in a heavy burden on society and families; and

**Whereas**, 105,668 domestic violence offenses were reported in the State of Florida in 2016, including 52 incidents reported in the City of Venice; and

**Whereas**, we must work together to educate our community about what can be done to prevent domestic violence and how to support survivors; and

**Whereas**, with leadership, dedication and encouragement there is compelling evidence that we can be successful in reducing domestic violence through prevention education, increased awareness and holding perpetrators who commit acts of violence responsible for their actions; and

**Whereas**, Safe Place and Rape Crisis Center (SPARCC) provides free services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault and their children in Sarasota and Desoto Counties, seeks to stop the crime of domestic violence through public awareness and education; and

**Whereas**, SPARCC encourages every citizen to actively engage in public and private efforts, including conversations about domestic violence, how to prevent it, how to help survivors connect with services, and how every segment of our society can work together to better address domestic violence.


