RESOLUTION NO. 2017-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, ENCOURAGING ADVISORY BOARDS TO ESTABLISH A SUMMER RECESS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the city council typically observes a month-long summer recess, currently by canceling its second regular meeting in July and its first regular meeting in August; and

WHEREAS, advisory boards are encouraged to establish a similar summer recess in order to allow board members and staff to better accommodate summer vacations; and

WHEREAS, certain advisory boards have review deadlines established by Florida law or the City's Code of Ordinances that will prevent the establishment of a summer recess.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The above Whereas clauses are ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. To the extent feasible, the city council directs all advisory boards to establish a month-long summer recess generally concurrent with the summer recess of city council.

SECTION 3. Upon adoption, a copy of this resolution will be provided to each board chair.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, as provided by law.
