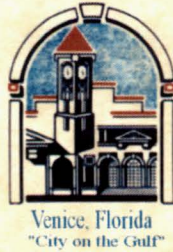

Whereas, during Family Caregivers Month, we recognize the challenges families and caregivers face when their loved ones need Caregiving Around the Clock!


Now, Therefore, I, John W. Holic, Mayor of the City of Venice, Florida, on behalf of the Venice City Council do hereby proclaim November 2017 as
