SUBJECT: Fire and Police Impact Fees

Background:

On July 10, 2017, Stantec Consulting Services (Stantec) presented the preliminary results of the fire impact fee study. At that meeting, City Council directed city staff to pursue a study for a police impact fee. Staff provided data to Stantec for a thorough evaluation of the implementation of a police impact fee.

On August 22, 2017, Stantec presented the preliminary results of the fire and police impact fee study. At that meeting, City Council directed city staff to draft a fire and police impact fee ordinance.

Stantec will be presenting their updated fire and police impact fee results to support the Public Safety Impact Fee Ordinance
