

Principles of Agreement – Sarasota County Responsibilities

- Continue to operate and maintain all parks contained within the current Interlocal Agreement through September 30, 2019.
- Operate and maintain the following parks as part of a new agreement (consistent with the provisions of the current Interlocal Agreement):

Venice Beach

Marina Park and Boat Ramp

Brohard Park

East side of Venetian Waterway Park

Chuck Reiter Park (through September 30, 2021)

• The term will be for an initial 5 years, with the option for annual extensions, not to exceed to a total of 5 additional years.



Principles of Agreement – City of Venice Responsibilities

 Assume responsibility of the following City-owned parks effective October 1, 2019:

Chauncy Howard Park; Pinebrook Park;

Heigel Park and Boat Ramp; Venice Myakka River Park;

Hecksher Park; Venice Community Center; and,

Legacy Park; West Side of Venetian Waterway Park.

- Make capital improvements at Venice Beach, Marina Park and Boat Ramp,
 Brohard Park, east side of Venetian Waterway Park and Chuck Reiter Park after an
 assessment is conducted by City and County staff.
- Assume responsibility for maintenance and operation of Chuck Reiter Park effective October 1, 2021.



Principles of Agreement – Wellfield Park

- Wellfield Park will become a County-owned or -leased regional park effective in 2018.
- Pinebrook Park is not included and will be the responsibility of the City.
- The park area will include the entire Wellfield Park parcel including the tennis courts and existing parking.
- The County requires an extension of the northern and eastern boundary of the northern parking lot (approximately 133 additional spaces) which will be by mutual consent of the parties.

Need Policy Direction – Wellfield Park

- The County has requested a deed for the property.
- The City has offered a 99 year lease.



Next Steps:

- Determine capital repairs needed City to repair.
- Finalize new agreement.
- Bring new agreement to County Commission / City Council for approval.
