| SUBJECT:      | Approval of an Agreement with Dewberry Architects, Inc. In The<br>Amount of \$870,257 for Professional Architectural and Engineering<br>Services for the City of Venice Public Safety Facility |

#### **Background**:

Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 3075-17 for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services for the City of Venice Public Safety Facility was distributed on November 18, 2017. Six (6) proposals were received on December 18, 2017.

On December 29, 2017, an evaluation committee met to review, discuss, and score the proposals received. The six (6) proposals were ranked in the following order and the top four (4) firms were invited in for interviews/presentations on January 12, 2018. The fourth ranked firm, Clemmons, Rutherford, and Associates, Inc., withdrew from consideration on January 8, 2018.

On January 12, 2018, the evaluation committee met again to hear oral presentations and conduct interviews with the remaining shortlisted proposers. The proposer's were ranked in the following order: 1) Dewberry Architects, Inc., 2) Harvard Jolly Architecture, and 3) Architects Design Group.

On January 23, 2018, City Council approved the ranking of the top three (3) firms and authorized staff to negotiate an agreement with the top ranked proposer, Dewberry Architects, Inc.

Staff has negotiated an Agreement with Dewberry Architects, Inc. This fee includes \$840,257 for Basic Design Services, plus an Allowance of \$30,000 for Reimbursable Expenses, for a total of \$870,257, which is congruent with the Owner's Representative's estimate of \$873,838, based on the <u>Florida DMS Fee Curve for A/E</u> with adjustments for additional scopes. The standard American Institute of Architects (AIA) Document B133-2014 has been attached for your reference.

#### **Requested Action:**

Approval of an Agreement with Dewberry Architects, Inc. in the amount of \$870,257 for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services for the City of Venice Public Safety Facility.
