Sec. 46-1. - Description of city parks system; authorized uses.

Such lands shall be used and developed exclusively for the enjoyment of the general public as public parks, including but not limited to such uses as playgrounds, playfields, quiet landscape areas, cultural activity areas, waterfront activity areas or any appropriate combination thereof.
