A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING VENETIAN WATERWAY PARK AND VENICE AREA BEAUTIFICATION, INC., IN THEIR EFFORTS; AUTHORIZING STAFF TO PROVIDE MAINTENANCE BY COUNTY PERSONNEL FOR COMPLETED SEGMENTS OF VENETIAN WATERWAY PARK.

WHEREAS, Venetian Waterway Park (f.k.a. Linear Park) is a recreational green way and trail proposed to be located along the banks of the Intracoastal Waterway in the incorporated limits of the City of Venice and unincorporated Sarasota County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners recognizes that Venetian Waterway Park will be an important recreational and alternative transportation route, as well as an improvement of public lands along the Intracoastal Waterway; and,

WHEREAS, the development of Venetian Waterway Park will be an important facility in complying with the current and future needs of the community, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have previously committed staff and resources for the Venetian Waterway Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SARASOTA, COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Sarasota County Government will provide maintenance for completed segments of Venetian Waterway Park by county personnel upon completion of each segment of Venetian Waterway Park.

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

**RE: AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA
DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAND AND WATER
CONSERVATION FUND FOR THE VENETIAN WATERWAY PARK SEGMENT 5
AT CASPERSEN BEACH.**

**WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sarasota County in the County's 1996
Capital Improvement Plan approved the addition of Caspersen Beach as a project within the
County's Capital Improvement Program; and**

**WHEREAS, this project is eligible to receive matching grant funds from the Florida Department
of Environmental Protection Land And Water Conservation Fund grants funded through state
funds administered by the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Land and
Water Conservation; and**

**WHEREAS, Parks and Recreation grant application requires a resolution from the Board of
County Commissioners, as governing body of the County, assuring a dollar-for-dollar match of
the grant request and sufficient funds will be available to operate the facility upon completion of
the project.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sarasota
County, Florida:**

- 1. That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, or his designee, is hereby
authorized to sign and submit the grant application for this project;**
- 2. That Sarasota County assures a dollar-for-dollar match for the fulfillment of the grant
request that may be awarded, and that such funds will be available and unencumbered
at the time of the grant award;**
- 3. That funding is sufficient and will be available in order that the project will result in a
completed canoe launch, fishing dock, and large picnic shelter and, upon completion,
sufficient funds will be available to maintain the facility;**
- 4. That Sarasota County owns and has legal title to the site referred to in this grant
application; and**
- 5. That the facility will be maintained so as to assure continued public access to the
improved amenities.**

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-071

RE: A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO PROHIBIT
PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE 700 AND 800 BLOCKS OF GOLF DRIVE IN VENICE

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 83-76 establishes the procedure for regulation of parking on
County roads, streets, bridges and rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Venice Area Beautification, Inc., the City of Venice and the Sarasota
County Parks and Recreation Department are building the Venetian Waterway Park on Golf
Drive in Venice, and

WHEREAS, the first segment of the Waterway Park, that includes the north side of Golf
Drive, is about to be completed, and

WHEREAS, the residents on the south side of Golf Drive are using the park area for their
cars, and

WHEREAS, the Sarasota County Traffic Advisory Council recommended that parking be
prohibited on both sides of the 700 and 800 blocks of Golf Drive, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that there is a need to prohibit
parking on both sides of the 700 and 800 blocks of Golf Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS:

That the No Parking Zone be created on both sides of the 700 and 800 blocks of Golf Drive and
that the Public Works Business Center is authorized to post the appropriate signs.
