Sec. 54-5. - Hauling waste within the city.

- (a) Requirements for hauling. Persons who desire to dispose of waste material not included in the definition of solid waste or otherwise not collected by the city, and collectors of solid waste from outside of the city who desire to haul over the streets of the city, shall use a watertight vehicle provided with a tight cover and so operated as to prevent offensive odors escaping therefrom and solid waste from being blown, dropped or spilled. Disposal of solid waste by persons so permitted shall be made outside the city limits unless otherwise specifically authorized by the director.
- (b) Adequate covers required. No person shall use or permit to be used any vehicle to convey solid waste, including sand, dirt, shell and redi-mix concrete, without providing and utilizing adequate equipment or covers for fastening and retaining such material within any vehicle so as to prevent spillage, leakage or littering from such vehicle.
