City of Venice PRIVATE WASTE HAULER PERMIT

- Stand alone, open top dumpster, typically for commercial garbage or construction debris
- Sizes: 10, 20, 30 & 40 Cubic Yards
- Delivered to jobsite, emptied and returned as needed
- Some permanent locations for businesses
- City offers these services, as do several private companies











PRIVATE WASTE HAULER

- Private collectors who engage in the business of collecting, hauling and disposing of commercial waste and construction debris
- NOT building contractors who use their own equipment
- Companies NOT located in City
 - WSI Clearwater (National)
 - WCA Sarasota (National)
 - WastePro Sarasota (National)
 - Waste Management S. Venice (County)
 - Fuggedaboutit Dumpsters S. Venice (County)
 - Daddy's Dumpsters S. Venice (County)



- Not currently regulated No accountability
- Protection of Public Property
 - Sidewalks, Streets, Curbs, Signs, Spills



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- Public Safety Concerns
 - Traffic Safety
 - Night-time Visibility
 - Loading & Unloading



- Proper disposal techniques
 - County Landfill Recycled Debris



WASTE HAULER PERMIT PROCESS

- A Permit program to properly track and manage these private waste haulers operating within City limits.
- Permit issued annually to private Waste Hauler Companies.
- Will contain important Permit Conditions:
 - Company contact information
 - Certificate of Insurance / Licenses
 - Record of Dumpster Locations within the City
 - Record of disposal quantities
 - Verification of proper disposal practices
 - Dumpster placement requirements, for safety and protection of public property

WASTE HAULER PERMIT PROCESS

- Preferable to fully closing the borders
- Other Municipalities are successful with this process
- Larger Companies are already familiar with this process
- Permit application fee assessed annually
- Percentage of gross revenue, paid monthly (Typically 10-15%)
- Estimated Annual Revenue:
 - 80 containers x \$300/pull x 2 pulls per month
 - $= $48,000 \times 12 = $576,000 \times .15 = $86,400 \text{ per year}$
- Must include proper enforcement with compliance fines

CITY OF LAKELAND - PERMIT PROCESS

- Private Haulers pay monthly permit fee of 15% of gross revenue from preceding month
- FY 17/18 annual revenues from this program was \$1,070,855

CITY OF CLEARWATER - PERMIT PROCESS

- Private Haulers pay monthly permit fee of 15% of gross revenue from preceding month
- FY 17/18 annual revenues from this program was \$580,000

CITY OF ST. PETERSBURG - PERMIT PROCESS

- Private Haulers pay monthly permit fee based on quantity of garbage removed (\$1.92/CY).
- FY 17/18 annual revenues from this program was \$175,000

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Work with City Attorney to draft Private Waste Hauler Permit Process Ordinance
- 2. Bring Permit Process Ordinance to City Council for adoption
- 3. Implement new Permit Process & Enforcement with Private Haulers
