The mission of the Venice Museum & Archives is to collect, preserve and interpret historical and prehistorical material relating to the City of Venice and its neighboring communities.

The vision statement proposal that we are recommending is as follows:

The Venice Museum & Archives will serve as a critical community asset that preserves the past and prepares the present to meet the future.
