- Lord-Higel House Parking Lot Design Work Assignment in Process
- Mobi-Mat Installation at Venice Beach (ADA Improvements) -Plans being reviewed by FDEP and coordination with SC
- Phase III Paving Road Bond Determining Road Segments/Preparing Bid Documents.
- Stormwater Outfall Testing Desk top pollutant modelling underway. Sampling being scheduled dependent on rain events.
- Stormwater Rate Study Data analysis initiated. Stakeholders Group to be set up.

 - Under major construction




Projects Under Construction:

Original Fence Design


