SUBJECT: Update on and Action Plan Strategy for Septic Systems in City of Venice

Background: The purpose of this presentation is to update Council and communicate the action plan strategy for the City's remaining septic systems.

The Utilities Department has determined that there are no septic systems in the City of Venice (out of the 45 existing systems) that are not in compliance with our code. Through our investigation we have created maps to illustrate the septic systems in surrounding areas and within City limits.

We would like to begin educational outreach on septic systems, and provide system inspection by a Certified Septic Tank Contractor on a voluntary basis at no fee to the customer.
