Whereas, volunteerism brings people together to tackle society's tough challenges, spark change, and build stronger, more resilient communities; and

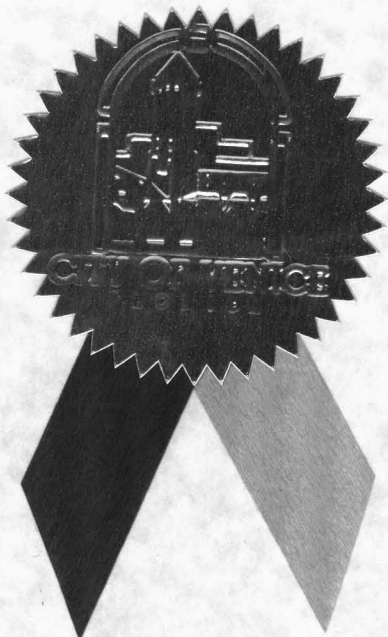
Whereas, volunteers not only serve the community with pride and commitment, but help to make the City of Venice a great place to live; and

Whereas, the theme of this year's event is "Celebrate Service" as an effort to shine a light on the people and causes that inspire us to serve; and


