Background: Propose to institute a Police K-9 program at Venice High School to detect illicit items from entering the campus such as drugs, weapons, and other illegal items. The purpose of instating the program is to provide a higher level of campus safety for teachers, students, parents, school department workers, and guests. The program may require more than one K-9 to detect all of the illicit items.

Requested Action: The Venice Police Department requests authorization to utilize the Forfeiture Fund to initially purchase one (1) dog for K-9 purposes at the Venice High School, estimated cost of \$5,000.00
