

Fire and Rescue Facts and Figures

Venice has a <u>City</u> Fire Dept. and a <u>County</u> Ambulance Service

A 911 call for a medical issue will get you a County Ambulance and a City Fire Truck

The City Fire Truck annual budget is \$10 Million; the County Ambulance Service costs Venice taxpayers \$2.8 Million

In 2017, Venice had 3,400 calls; 5 for structure fires and 2,200 supporting the County Ambulance

Cost per call for the City Fire Truck is \$3,000

Cost per transport for the County Ambulance is \$1,000

Venice now wants to take over the County Ambulance Service
