SUBJECT: Approval to Apply for and Accept Funds for the Recycling Partnership Coastal Grant

Background: As part of the proposed transition to single stream recycling collection, the Public Works Department is applying for the Recycling Partnership Coastal Grant to help fund the purchase of automated recycling carts. This grant funding would support the transition of residential collection from the existing 14-gallon red bins to 65-gallon automated carts. In addition to providing the cart funding, this grant will also provide funding for community education and outreach, coastal cleanup efforts, and public space recycling containers. The total grant funding being requested within this application is summarized below:

Automated Recycling Carts (10,532 customers) = \$157,980 Community Education and Outreach = \$10,532 Coastal Clean-Up Efforts = \$10,000 Public Space Recycling Containers = \$10,000 Total Requested Grant Funding = \$188,512

It is anticipated that the City's transition to single stream recycling would occur in early 2020, in conjunction with Sarasota County.
