ORDINANCE NO. 2019-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 74, UTILITIES, ARTICLE II, WATER, DIVISION 2, CAPACITY CHARGE; SECTION 74-72, AMOUNT; ARTICLE III, SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL; DIVISION 3, CAPACITY CHARGE; SECTION 74-162, AMOUNT; BY MODIFYING UTILITY CAPACITY CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is well known that the water and wastewater infrastructure of the United States requires major investment to sustain the economic vitality and life styles to which citizens have become accustomed; and

WHEREAS, it is important to implement an effective capital improvement program, including a renewal and replacement component, in order to effectively and proactively sustain current water and wastewater infrastructure as well as better accommodate the impacts of such things as wear and tear, regulations, and new customers upon these systems; and

WHEREAS, analysis has determined the current schedule of capacity charges may be modified to more accurately recover the costs associated with the provision of water and wastewater services; and

WHEREAS, city council finds that the proposed schedule of capacity charges is reasonable and fair to fund the department's costs involved in the provision of water and wastewater services; and

WHEREAS, analysis has determined a more equitable schedule of charges amongst all new utility connections; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The whereas clauses above are ratified and confirmed as true and correct.

SECTION 2. Chapter 74, Utilities; Article II, Water; Division 2, Capacity Charge; Section 74-72, Amount, is amended to read as follows:
