SUBJECT: Chapter 74 Utilities Ordinance Revision

Background: Establishing an adequate financial plan is an important component in a well-managed and operated water and sewer utility. A well-designed financial plan provides sufficient funding to allow communities to build, operate, maintain, and reinvest in their utility systems. Properly and adequately funded utility systems also allow for the economic development and sustainability of the local community.

The capacity fees that are imposed on new connections have become an important part of the comprehensive financing plans of many utilities. The City of Venice's water plant capacity fees were last updated in 1990 and the sewer plant capacity fees in 1983. Therefore, the department secured the services of Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. to perform professional services related to the capacity charges currently in place.

The only changes to the ordinance is in Chapter 74, Sections 74-72 and 74-162, which lists the plant capacity charges.
