VILLAGE ON THE ISLE - MARK MANOR RENOVATION

On behalf of our client, The Southwest Florida Retirement Center, Inc., this narrative and supporting documentation are submitted for review in support of a Site and Development Amendment approval for the Village on the Isle – Mark Manor Renovation in Venice, Florida.

The project is located at 900 South Tamiami Trail, Venice, FL 34285 (Section 18, Township 39 South, Range 19 East). The property area is comprised of one parcel and totals approximately ±15.59 acres (including the land swap with the church). The proposed improvements include interior renovations to the existing Mark Manor building as with exterior building façade changes to match the recently approved building architecture (No. 17-09SP) for the three new buildings under construction at the Village on the Isle (VOTI) Campus. The façade changes include the removal of the existing parapet wall and replacement with roof treatments that do not exceed the height of the original Mark Manor building.

Copies of the previously approved colored building elevations for Phase 1a (No. 17-09SP) have been included for reference and comparison. The proposed façade changes will also utilize the color, materials, and features/treatments previously shown and approved on the material board with Phase 1a.

In addition to the requested review and approval of the façade changes for Mark Manor, the applicant will be proposing in the near future similar façade changes to Matthew Hall, Trinity Hall, and the Commons area buildings.

The applicant is requesting approval of these future façade changes under the assumption and understanding that the proposed building elevations are similar in color, materials, and architectural features as those previously approved. It would be also understood and assumed that the building height of the future façade changes are consistent with the requirements from the Comprehensive plan for the VOTI Campus. As long as the future building elevations / façades are consistent with those previously approved, as determined by Planning Staff, the future changes to the building façades do not need additional approval by Planning Commission.

Architectural Description: New Building Exterior Design Approach

Facade improvements for Village on The Isle are planned to be compatible with the character of existing structures on campus (Comprehensive Plan Policies 19.2E and 15.7) while also being consistent with a direction that supports the Northern Italian Renaissance / Mediterranean Revival Style (VUD Section 86-122(I) as a theme embraced by the City of Venice.

The alterations to building facades for the Village on The Isle campus will include their building form and exterior treatment in harmony with other existing buildings and buildings currently under construction (previously approved). Building massing will incorporate hipped roof forms, flat roof areas and façade offsets consistent with the Mediterranean Revival Style. Faux balconies, awnings, and terraces will provide smaller scale elements that add variety to building form.

Exterior facade detailing proposed for buildings at Village on The Isle will provide another layer of architectural elements compatible with the Mediterranean Revival theme. The use of colored stucco as the primary cladding system will help to unify campus structures. Simple window groupings with stucco head and sill trim, selective shutter placement, stucco cornice trim, stucco profiled trim and metal railings will complete the new buildings and reinforce a consistent architectural language.

It is anticipated that the exterior architectural approach described here will support the City of Venice's architectural theme and reinforce the setting for the Village on the Isle campus going forward.
