Chapter 89 – Environmental Regulations

**Trees** (formerly Chapter 118 Tree Preservation, Protection & Replacement)

### What are the Key Changes / Major Topics of this Regulation?

- Replacing Chapter 118 and County Standards per Ord No. 83-44
  County Tree Protection Ordinance
- Provide clear (and updated) Standards for the planting / replanting, removal, and maintenance of trees in conjunction with Florida Friendly Landscaping Standards
- Address standards adopted as part of F.S. § 163.045



# What are the Key Changes / Major Topics of this Regulation to current Sarasota County?

- Updated Definitions
  - More technical arboricultural terminology
    - Tree Inch (Caliper & DBH)
    - Problem Tree
    - Tree Category Classifications
- Prohibitions, Exemptions & Permits
  - Creates a "Tree Permit" application process
    - Including master tree plan
- Tree Preservation & Replacement Standards
  - Determining Suitability for Removal / Preservation
  - Flexibility and Incentive Options
- "Tree Mitigation Fund"
- Enforcement



# When is a Tree Permit Required?

#### Commercial / Multi – Family/ PUD/ Industrial

- ✓ Pruning & Trimming of any Heritage or Venetian Tree
- ✓ Removal of a Protected, Heritage or Venetian Tree
  - Must present a safety hazard, the tree is in decline/ diseased/ injured

#### Residential (Single Family Lot/ Homeowner)

- Note: Criteria will be dependent on adoption of F.S. § 163.045
- ✓ Pruning & Trimming of any Heritage or Venetian Tree
- ✓ Removal of a Protected, Heritage or Venetian Tree
  - Must present a safety hazard, the tree is in decline/ diseased/ injured

#### Current Sarasota Code Requires a tree permit:

- for tree removal or relocation.
- pruning or causing irreparable injury to trees in a Canopy Road Protection Zone or Right-of-Way.
- planting trees or other vegetation within the Right-of-Way.



# **Prohibitions, Exemptions & Permits**

- Prohibitions (Not authorized without a Permit)
  - Tree Removal
  - Tree Relocation
  - Initiate Development When a Protected Tree Exists on a Property
  - Cause Irreparable Injury to a Tree

#### Exemptions

- Emergencies (waived by Mayor, City Council, City Manager)
- Agricultural Land, Tree Farms, Nurseries
- Public Utilities & Telecommunication Towers
- Solar Access
- FS 163.045 (Proposed Bill favoring removal from private residential lots)

#### Permits

- Application and Fee
- Tree Protection and Replacement Plan



### **Trees**







#### **Protected Trees**

- Any tree over 4 inch DBH, unless invasive
- Sabal Palms with a minimum 6-foot Clear
  Trunk

 Sarasota County Protected Trees

#### **Heritage Tree**

 Native, Single Trunk 30 – inch DBH or greater.

Multi-Trunk Tree 45- inch DBH or greater

 Sarasota County Grand Tree is any tree that meets the size criteria based on diameter+height (average spread). They are replaced on an inch per inch basis or \$200.00/ dbh into the tree fund.

#### **Venetian Trees**

 Specific Native & Non- Native trees designated by the City of Venice City Council as having a historic or cultural significance.



### **Tree Preservation**

#### **Incentives Replacement**

- 1. Retain native trees 24-inch DBH greater, receive two times DBH incentive
- 2. Retain clusters of six or more protected trees, receive 1.5 times DBH incentive
- 3. Retain native clusters of six protected trees with native understory, receive 1 inch per 1000 SF
- 4. Larger Tree Caliper Inches Provided (6-inch greater)
- Required Best Management Practices for Pruning

The Intent is to maintain existing tree canopy in City of Venice and incentivize retention of existing trees/addition of larger trees



## **Tree Replacement**

- Project Area Density of Forty (40) tree inches per acre is required for mitigation. (Includes all properties except for industrial use or exempted)
  - Example: 1 Acre x 40 Inches = A minimum of 16 2.5" Caliper Trees Required or combination of a total of 40 inches planted on site.
- Heritage and Venetian Trees will be replaced at on a DBH inch for DBH inch basis (ex: if a 12 DBH inch tree is removed then 12 Caliper inches need to be added to the site)
- Required Best Management Practices for Replacement Planting
- Inclusion of Florida Friendly Landscaping Master Tree Species List

#### Current Sarasota Code Requires a tree permit:

- Minimum of one tree required for each 2000 sf
  - Minimum of 8 feet in height and trunk diameter (caliper) of at least two inches
  - Example: 1 Acre / 2000 SF = A minimum of 22 2" Individual Caliper Trees Required (Note that this is an equivalent of a minimum of 44 inches/ acre of replacement)
- Grand trees will be replaced on an DBH inch for DBH inch basis.



# "Tree Mitigation Fund"

### What it the Tree Mitigation Fund?

• A fund for the planting, protection and maintenance of trees on public property within the City of Venice.

### Following Project Types

- Conservation or Natural Preserve Area and Protection
- Qualified Attainable Housing Projects
- Urban Forest Assessments
- Mitigation of Negative Environmental Impacts

More flexible and stringent than County Tree Bank Program



### **Enforcement**

- Enforced Via Code of Ordinances
  - Chapter 2: City Code Enforcement
- Fees are comparable to current Sarasota County Fees
- After the Fact Permit Required for any Illegal Removal (Language that will be addressed)
  - Tree Removal (Illegally) and Replacement
    - (2x permit fee plus original mitigation)
- Optional Payment To Tree Mitigation Fund
  - \$150 per tree inch removed; \$175 per tree inch removed (Heritage/Venetian)
