SUBJECT: Downtown Public Parking Signage Layout – Recommended Locations

Background: The Public Works Department has historically installed public parking wayfinding signs to help direct visitors to the public parking areas within, and adjacent to, the Venice downtown district. During the recent Downtown Beautification Project, some of these signs were removed, and there are several different styles of public parking signage currently in place. As directed by Council, Public works has reviewed the sign locations and offers the attached Public Parking Signage - Layout Map, for Council review and discussion. Public Works would also recommend we chose a single signage style and color, to be used consistently throughout the downtown district. It is our intent to get the sign locations identified, and to proceed with installation of the updated signage prior to this coming tourist season.

Requested Action: Direct Public Works staff to install standard public parking signage at designated locations throughout the Venice downtown district.
