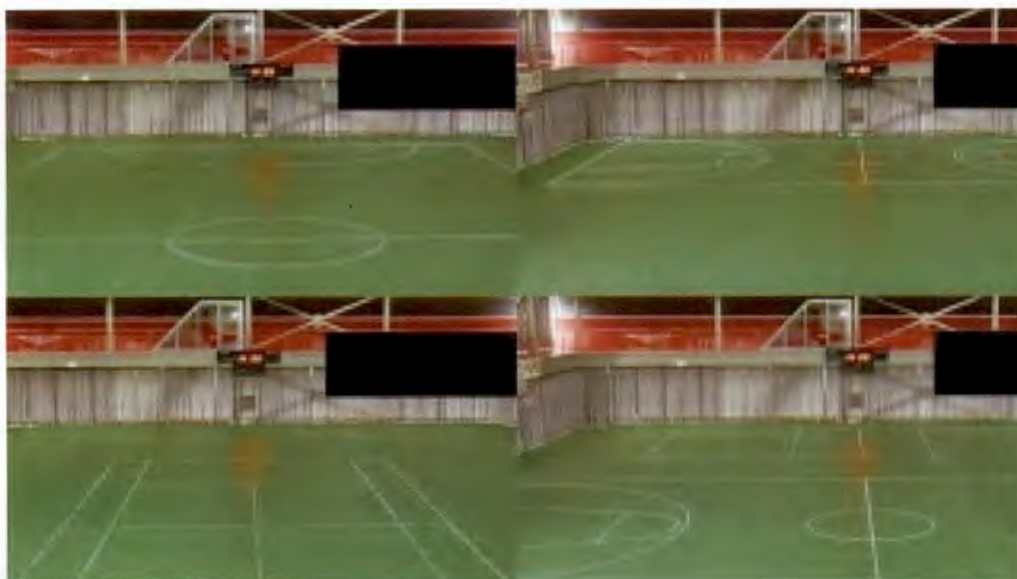


Meet the LED Volleyball-Basketball-Tennis Court of the Future
