


Comments are all over the place, but one basic theme....folks are watching and aware of what is being done in COV. Last election was won/lost by 69 votes.

Mayor Holic and Council Members,

Due to some inaccuracies I have seen in news reports, I wished to clarify the effect of Council's vote on Tuesday related to Ordinance No. 2019-19 (GCCF). By a 3-3 vote, approval of the Ordinance failed, resulting in a denial of the rezone petition. There is no provision in City Code that automatically rolls tie votes to another meeting where all members are present. A written order of denial is being processed as required by Florida law. Pursuant to Section 86-47(j)(1) of the City Code, as a result of the denial the Planning Commission cannot consider "any further application for the rezoning of any part or all of the same property to the same zoning district for a period of 12 months from the date of such action" unless such limitation is waived by 4 affirmative votes of Council to prevent injustice or to facilitate the proper development of the city.
