STRATEGIC PLAN GOAL: Ensure a Financially Sound City

SUBJECT: Disposal of Surplus Vehicles and Heavy Equipment.

Background:

I have reviewed the items listed below and recommends disposal per the City's fixed asset policy.

- 1) 2005 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 461, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 2) 2011 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 462, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 3) 2011 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 475, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 4) 2010 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 476, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 5) 2010 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 477, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 6) 2010 Crane Carrier Recycle Unit 478, Solid Waste/Recycling
- 7) 2006 Mack Front Loader Unit 470. Solid Waste/Recycling
- 8) 2002 Ford F350 Crane Truck Unit 200, Utilities
- 9) 2004 Ford E250 Crime Van Unit 84, Police
- 10) 2004 Pierce Contender Engine Unit 154, Fire

Upon Council approval, staff shall list these items other than the Pierce Engine, at Auction with Royal Auctions in Ft Myers, Florida. Royal is a live auction with an on-line bidding option. The public will be notified through City social media approximately two weeks before the auction to allow local bidder participation. Proceeds from the disposal auction will go to the individual departments within the 505 Fleet Fund for the funding of future fleet unit replacements.

The Pierce Engine will be listed with a reserve amount with the on-line auction company Public Surplus. If reserve is not meet, it will be listed and marketed for sale with Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus, and sold through their on line source. This method will be used to insure we are getting a fair market value for the engine.

The Auctions will be scheduled after the replacement units arrive, and when the recycling trucks are no longer necessary for dual stream collection.

Requested Action:

Approval to dispose of Units # 461, 462, 475, 476, 477, 478, 470, 200, 84, and 154 at auction.
