



Water Quality

- Stormwater Outfall Testing -
 - Additional Sampling Authorized underway weather dependent
 - Updated desk top pollutant modelling to include all Island Outfalls (39 total)
 - State Legislature Grant being drafted by FDEP \$100,000
 - SWFWMD Grant being drafted for \$75,000
 - ▶ Upon receipt of grant agreements will present to City Council to execute and initiate next phase including flow meters at all outfalls, automatic samplers at top 5 outfalls and prepare prioritization plan.
 - ► Funding Options: In process of submitting applications for next years funding programs to upgrade Outfall 1 (Venice Beach) to redirect flow and upgrade swale system.
- Stormwater Rate Study Data analysis initiated.
 - Comprehensive system analysis underway
 - Stakeholder's Group being compiled once we complete need assessment

Project Under Design:

- ► Beach Renourishment Physical Monitoring Report underway.

- ► Tarpon Center/Park Blvd. Corridor system upgrades and water quality improvements Work Assignment awarded.
- Outfall 1 & 2 (Venice Beach/Alhambra) Initial Conceptual Design - Work assignment to be awarded after Grant Agreement.
- ► Lord Higel House Parking Area Under Design for upgrades to pave parking lot.

 - Triple Diamond including Morse Ct.,
 - Technology Way/Precision Drive
 - Bird Bay South
 - San Marco
 - Hatchett Creek and Plumosa
 - Pinebrook Way Area
 - Seaboard Area Streets (Warfield, Grove, Spur & Alleys)

Project Preparing for Construction

- Capri Isles Bridge 100% Design Plans approved by FDOT. Preparing to advertise for construction services and CEI services (\$1 million FDOT funding/remaining Road Bond)
- Phase III Streets any remaining streets (2020)
 Live Oak being paved with Live Oak Drainage Project.
 - Sister streets included in Utilities Bid
 - Gulf Coast Blvd. to be included in Utilities Bid repairs underway.
- ► Inlet Dredging by ACOE deposit sand near North Jetty staring early November

Other Work Efforts:

- ► ADA Transition Plan Update GIS update of improvements completed to date with various projects including facility upgrades.
- ► GIS Updates/TV Testing field investigations and GIS database upgrades/infrastructure evaluation
- MPO Technical Advisory Committee
 - Priority Project/Funding Options for Transportation Projects
 - October City Council Priority for MPO & Impact Fee Funding (Consistent with CIS adopted in May 2019)
 - December Project Submittal to MPO for Work Program
 - ► Long Range Transportation Plan
 - Congestion Management Plan
- Stormwater Management Plan Update evaluation of all facilities, establishing a short and long term comprehensive maintenance/replacement plan.
