SUBJECT: Resolution 2019-29 to Establish a Stormwater Utility Rate and Water Quality Improvement

Stakeholder's Work Group

Background: The City of Venice established a Stormwater Utility in 1995 and set Stormwater Utility Rates based on type of land use through Resolution 95-17. An update of the resolution was completed in 2006 by Resolution No. 2006-21, however, no modification of the rates were completed, therefore, the stormwater rates have not been updated since 1995.

The Stormwater Stakeholder's Group was initially established with 5 members to address additional revenue to operate and maintain the stormwater system. In order to more effectively address water quality upgrades that are a top priority of City Council, this resolution recommends to increase the membership to 7 members to increase the stakeholder input as water quality project including the required funding is established. As the majority of the stormwater directly discharges to the creeks, bays, Intracoastal Waterway and Gulf of Mexico, establishing a capital improvement project that not only addressed upgrading failing infrastructure but includes water quality enhancement projects is essential.

Requested Action: Approve Resolution 2019-29 creating a Stormwater Utility Rate and Water Quality Improvement Stakeholder's Work Group and Providing an Effective Date.
