SUBJECT: Accept Donations – Downtown Shark Spotting Sculptures and Plaque

**Background:** This downtown shark scavenger hunt concept was presented and approved by City Council on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The Gulf Coast Community Foundation (GCCF) has since commissioned and received ten bronze shark sculptures and one informational plaque. They have also worked directly with the Public Works Department to finalize the proposed locations within Downtown Venice. Each location has been selected and reviewed for public safety and suitability. The attached map displays the proposed sculpture locations, which will be installed by the Public Works Department. All installation supplies will also be donated by the GCCF.

The Public Art Advisory Board reviewed and approved the proposal at their January 8<sup>th</sup> board meeting and the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board reviewed and approved the proposal at their January 27<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Finally, GCCF will be coordinating with the City PIO in order to create an online media platform and advertising campaign for this exciting project.
