Sarasota County continues to partner with the City of Venice in providing parks and recreation service to the community by maintaining and operating designated City parks and facilities as outlined in the 2011 Interlocal Agreement (Contract No. 2011-421). In accordance with the agreement, the County submits annual reports to the City that provide operational, maintenance and financial summaries of services provided within the designated City parks for the preceding fiscal year.

Attached, please find the Fiscal Year 2018 Annual Report that highlights noteworthy programs and events and outlines completed maintenance projects. Also included is a list of needed capital repairs and improvements that fall within the City's area of responsibility. According to the Interlocal Agreement, the City is responsible for all needed repairs and improvements exceeding \$5,000, per park, per year, adjusted annually for the Consumer Price Index, (\$5,169.92 for FY18).

SARASOTA COUNTY PARKS, RECREATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES ANNUAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 CITY OF VENICE

Overview

In accordance with the requirements of Interlocal Agreement 2011-421 Regarding Parks and Recreation Service, this annual report provides a summary of Sarasota County Parks, Recreation and Natural Resources activities within designated city parks (as defined in Exhibit A of the Interlocal Agreement) for Fiscal Year 2018 (FY18). The services provided include program delivery, mowing, landscape bed maintenance, chemical application, irrigation, playground equipment inspections and maintenance, recreation amenity maintenance, athletic court maintenance, and janitorial services within designated city parks. The replacement and repair of amenities within the Designated City Parks shall not exceed \$5,000 per park, per year adjusted annually for the Consumer Price Index (CPI), which would have been \$5,169.92 for FY18. Also enclosed, please find a list of needed capital improvements and repairs per park.

Maintenance and Special Projects

Brohard Park and Paw Park

 Red tide clean-up and monitoring, damaged boardwalk removed, dune replanting/protections, shower tower and pad installation, parking lot landscaping, shell spread along the edges of the asphalt beach access path, crab traps and storm debris removed, gates replaced and repaired

Maxine Barritt Park

 Red tide clean up and monitoring, safety signage added, landscaping improvements, safety bollard relocations, repairs made to large pavilion roof, exotic plant removal, bat exclusion at the large pavilion, repairs made to the roofs of the existing bat boxes, coordination with city staff on the install of memorial plaques and donated benches, trimming completed to open up the viewshed at overlook #3

Service Club Park

 Red tide clean-up and monitoring, exotic removal, interior of the restrooms painted, restroom window louvers repaired/replaced, sidewalk cracks repaired, crab traps and storm debris removed

Chauncy Howard Park

• Red tide clean-up and monitoring, mulch added, exotic plant removal

Chuck Reiter Park

Replaced irrigation well pump.

Hecksher Park

- Power washed and re-sealed shuffleboard courts.
- Power washed all sidewalks and tile roof of ADA restrooms.

Higel Marine Park

Wellfield Park/Pinebrook Park

- New water fountains with water bottle dispensers installed in the facility.

Venice Beach

 Red tide clean-up and monitoring, pavilion pressuring washing, buried bench replaced, crab traps and storm debris removed, curbs painted, volleyball net hardware repaired/replaced, damaged phone line feeding the lifeguard tower repaired, concrete benches painted.

Venetian Waterway Park

- Worked with GIS and coordinated the purchase (Friends of the Legacy Trail, City of Venice, Venice Area Beautification, Inc.) and installation of new Emergency Decals along both sides of the Venetian Waterway Park.
- Monitored trash and mowing contractors
- Contracted concrete repair on both East and West VWP (replacement of concrete and expansion joints, and concrete grinding).
- Coordinated with Keep Venice Beautiful (KVB) volunteers to maintain trail by providing occasional staff and equipment.
- Targeted, removed and herbicide treated Brazilian pepper, carrotwood, lead tree along trail.
- Maintained trees and appropriate canopy height along trail.
- Coordinated with West Coast Inland Navigational District (WCIND).
- Coordinated with Country Club Estates on a volunteer effort to sand and paint lights along section of trail.

Financial

Many business units within Sarasota County Government assist in the operations and maintenance of the designated city parks. Each unit utilizes different methodologies and systems in the tracking of the associated expenditures. In addition to Parks, Recreation and Natural Resources information, staff obtained information from Facilities Maintenance and Office of Financial Management in the development of the unaudited financials provided below.
