RE: Ordinance 2020-11 - Camping and Storage of Personal Property on Public Property

In 2017, Sarasota County convened meetings with the staff of each municipality in the County, the Sheriff's Office, State Attorney's Office, Public Defender's Office, and representatives of the American Civil Liberties Union and Suncoast Partnership to End Homelessness to collect input on a draft Quality of Life ordinance. The goal was for each municipality to have uniformity in their ordinances, removing conflicts or gaps, with a County ordinance. The County adopted the final version of the ordinance on November 14, 2017. The attached proposed Ordinance is substantively identical to the County's ordinance.
