SUBJECT: State of Emergency Status for COVID-19

Background: The city issued a state of emergency on March 16, 2020, which has since automatically extended in seven day increments. Based on the status of the pandemic and new CDC guidelines, staff is rescinding the city's state of emergency on June 27, 2021 in tandem with the expiration of the Governor's state of emergency. Upon termination of the local state of emergency, the two executive orders that are still in effect will also terminate, which relate to 1) mobile food dispensing vehicles and 2) outside dining and temporary signs. This will give staff time to take the necessary measures to accommodate these items through Code changes as needed.

Staff is recommending that Zoom continue to be used for city council and planning commission meetings to facilitate greater citizen participation. City council adopted a resolution outling the accepted reasons for attending a meeting remotely (copy provided in agenda packet). However, as of July 1 it is recommended that Zoom be discontinued for all other boards, committees and work groups. Hybrid Zoom meetings require three staff members per meeting vs. one staff member.

Requested Action: Accept staff's recommendation to continue with Zoom for city council and planning commission, but return to regular in person meetings for all other boards as of July 1, 2021.
