The City is also preparing for a new Stormwater Rate Study which can affect the funding availability for projects on the LMS list.

It was determined that the next time the list is presented there will be a narrative describing the projects and why the LMS seems to show little funding available and how priorities are determined. Kathleen announced we have received funding for the firehouse generator through the HMGP grant program

Donna spoke about the new Countywide PPI committee. It will include all municipalities within Sarasota County and representatives from MOTE, Realtors, Insurance Agents and Communications department.
