D. PRESENTATIONS AND AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION - AGENDA ITEMS MAY BE DELAYED OR MOVED FORWARD TO ACCOMMODATE PRESENTATIONS

21-5077 Jenna Phillips, M.S., Sr. Project Engineer/Regional Office Lead and Angela Schedel, P.E., Director of Community Resilience, Taylor Engineering: Venice Resilience Plan (20 mins.)

Jenna Phillips, Taylor Engineering, provided a presentation and spoke on project background, adaptation planning process, review of past studies,

assessing vulnerabilities, sea level trends and projections, coastal flooding vulnerability assessment, and flood inundation scenarios.

Dr. Angela Schedel, Taylor Engineering, spoke on summary of vulnerability analysis, recommended focus areas, adaptation planning, constructing living shorelines, outreach survey and responses, and the Resilient Venice StoryMap website.

Ms. Phillips spoke regarding next steps.

Ms. Weeden commented on beach renourishment, back bay flooding, Tarpon Center Drive, and upgrading the seawall.

Discussion took place regarding state and federal funding for flood mitigation projects, sea level rise, and stormwater plan being included in the CIS.

Ms. Phillips and Ms. Schedel responded to council questions regarding the rate of sea level rise.

21-5078 Jenna Phillips, M.S., Sr. Project Engineer/Regional Office Lead, Taylor Engineering and Gary Serviss, LEED AP, SE Region Environmental Services Leader, VHB: Venice Stormwater Projects Update (20 mins.)

Ms. Phillips provided a presentation and spoke to project history, and water quality model inputs and results.

Gary Serviss, VHB, spoke on grab sample collections and results, storm event monitoring, monitoring equipment, discharge results, and water quality monitoring results.

Ms. Phililps spoke on preliminary priority projects, preliminary project options, and next steps.

Ms. Weeden spoke regarding the outfall at Venice Beach, funding long-term strategic plan, and completing stormwater management plan.

Ms. Phillips commented on target schedule.

Discussion followed regarding relationship between sea level rise and outfalls, measuring outfalls, red tide, septic tanks, the city partnering with other communities on prioritizing water quality projects, and the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council.

21-5079 City Arborist Jim Yelverton: Tree Preservation, Protection and Replacement (10 min.)

Mr. Yelverton provided a presentation and spoke on responsibilities, canopy cover goals and study progress, tree mitigation fund, and responded to council questions regarding percent of canopy trees on public property, developing a plan to identify planting sites, plan timeframe, providing public awareness on the Venetian Tree Program, tree mitigation in construction sites, advertising program, inventory of city owned trees, and working with developers.

Mr. Lavallee advised staff will provide a memorandum on the estimated cost of completing the canopy tree study at the budget workshop.

Discussion followed regarding designating a certain number of trees per year and tree removals.
